

Waiver for FAACT's Camp TAG (The Allergy Gang)

All families must agree that their camper(s) and/or any of their family members registered for FAACT's Camp TAG, will not attend Camp TAG if they have tested positive for Covid-19 within 14 days prior to the camp week, or any of the following is true prior to the first day of Camp TAG:

- Within the prior 14 days, you have been exposed to someone who has tested positive for Covid-19 (and have not had a post-exposure negative Covid-19 test), or are subject to a federal or local travel or quarantine advisory due to Covid-19.
- Within the prior 48 hours to the start of Camp TAG, if you have experienced symptoms of Covid-19 (e.g., fever of 100.4°F or higher, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, chills, repeated shaking, muscle pain/achiness, headache, sore throat, loss of taste or smell, nasal congestion, runny nose, vomiting, diarrhea, fatigue or any other symptoms identified by the CDC), and have not consulted a healthcare provider and gotten tested for Covid-19 before attending Camp TAG.
- Please note: According to the CDC, older adults and people of any age with serious underlying medical conditions may be at higher risk of death or severe illness from Covid-19. All attendees should evaluate their risk in determining whether to attend FAACT's Camp TAG.

Covid-19 Warning:

- You must follow all of FAACT's and its host camp's policies, including health and safety policies, and posted instructions while in the host camp's facility and their grounds.
- An inherent risk of exposure to Covid-19 and its variants exists in any public place where people are present. Covid-19 is an extremely dangerous disease that can lead to severe illness and death. While people of all ages and health conditions have been adversely affected by Covid-19, certain people have been identified by public health authorities as having greater risk based on age and/or underlying medical conditions.
- No precautions can completely eliminate the risk of Covid-19. By entering Camp TAG and its host camp sites, you voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to Covid-19 and its variants.

FAACT Requirements:

- Notify FAACT President & CEO, Eleanor Garrow-Holding, if you develop ANY symptoms during the Camp TAG week.
- Agree to abide by CDC and local health department recommendations and avoid any high-risk behaviors during the week of FAACT's Camp TAG.
